Qualifications:

1. Ability to lead worship with a strong vocal presence
2. Experience in leading worship teams/bands
3. Good people skills to work well with current Worship Team members
4. Ability to play one or more musical instruments well
5. Fluency in contemporary music/worship culture
6. Ability to connect with worshipers across generations and musical styles - creativity or worship planning is a plus
7. Familiarity with sound system technology is a plus

Responsibilities

1. Lead contemporary worship service Sunday evening, Monday morning, Tuesday evening campfire, Wednesday morning and Thursday evening. Lead a meal song and prayer at each meal.
2. Rehearse with band and vocalists daily before each service
3. Oversee set up of microphones then "re-set" the pavillion after the service is over
4. Work with the Camp Director in planning worship/ selecting music
5. Works with Tech Team to convey song selection, lyrics and order of lyrics no later than Saturday evening of each week
